The course designed to help students acquire the skill of making a presentation in pertinent vocabulary and expressions in the academic situation.</p> <p>● <b>Objectives of the Course</b> At the end of the lecture, students are to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• understand the way of basic presentations.</li> <li>• be able to give a presentation in pertinent vocabulary and expressions in the academic situation.</li> </ul> <p>● <b>Course Content or Plan</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prepare and perform four or five short speeches <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- talking about yourself</li> <li>- expressing your opinion</li> <li>- presenting academic data using PowerPoint</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>Other topics will be informed in the class and TACT.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Listening comprehension practice and small quizzes</li> </ul> <p>* The progress and contents of the lesson may change depending on the situation.</p> <p>● <b>Course Prerequisites and Related Courses</b> Class materials are designed for intermediary students. Students are required to have pre-intermediate knowledge of Japanese. Prerequisite subject for this course is Academic Japanese 1B (L &amp; P).
